Local Bakers Invited to Enter Emmanuel Country Fair's 'Best Chocolate Chip Cookie in Connecticut' Contest

Do you think that you make the one of the best chocolate chip cookies in the state? Enter the "Best Chocolate Chip Cookie in Connecticut" contest at the 110th annual Emmanuel Family Fair and find out! The Fair will be held, rain or shine, on the Emmanuel Church grounds at 285 Lyons Plains Road on September 17 from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Bakers of all ages are welcome to participate in the contest and there is no fee to enter.

GUIDELINES: Please bring one dozen homemade chocolate chip cookies, along with a list of ingredients (no secret ingredients allowed!) and your name and contact information to the Parish Hall kitchen by Noon on the day of the fair. Creativity is welcomed – cookies should include chocolate chips but beyond that, the sky is the limit and any ingredient is welcomed if you feel it should be included.

At one o'clock, the panel of dessert-loving judges will gather and begin tasting. Prizes will be given for First, Second and Third place before the Fair ends.
